## Steps for Value Added Products

### Step 1: For Preparation

- a. All raw product must be clean, refrigerated or frozen and free of rot.
- b. Please place in clean food grade containers or bins.
- c. All containers must be marked with Farms Name prior to pick up, Labels Can be supplied.

### Step 2: Placing Make Order

- a. Decide how much to send and what to make. We can help with suggestions.
- b. Chart with product ratios and pricing is on other side of page

### Step 3: Please fill out FISMA Sheet (will be supplied before pickup)

Product will be inspected as it comes to the plant.

Product needs to be food safe containers, Containers can be supplied if needed.

(this will be shipped at customers expense and all un-used buckets must be returned)

Please include written instructions along with the driver for processing.

\*\*\*Note No product will be processed if it is over 10% rot or full of trash.

We will charge extra if we have to "clean" product that is not required in normal prep.

\*\*example capping berries, peeling fruit, cleaning out green berries

### Step 4: Products will be made and Invoiced

- a. See next page for pricing
- b. Label and delivery is not included in pricing

### Step 5: Pick up, Delivery or ship

- a. Arrange with us for product return
- b. sell your produce or fruits all year long.

It is always a good idea to label your new Value added product "HomeGrown". It lets your customer know that each jar is special and made with absolute best produce available.

We recommend a 3 year shelf life on all of products. This allows you to extend your "selling season" past the "growing season"
